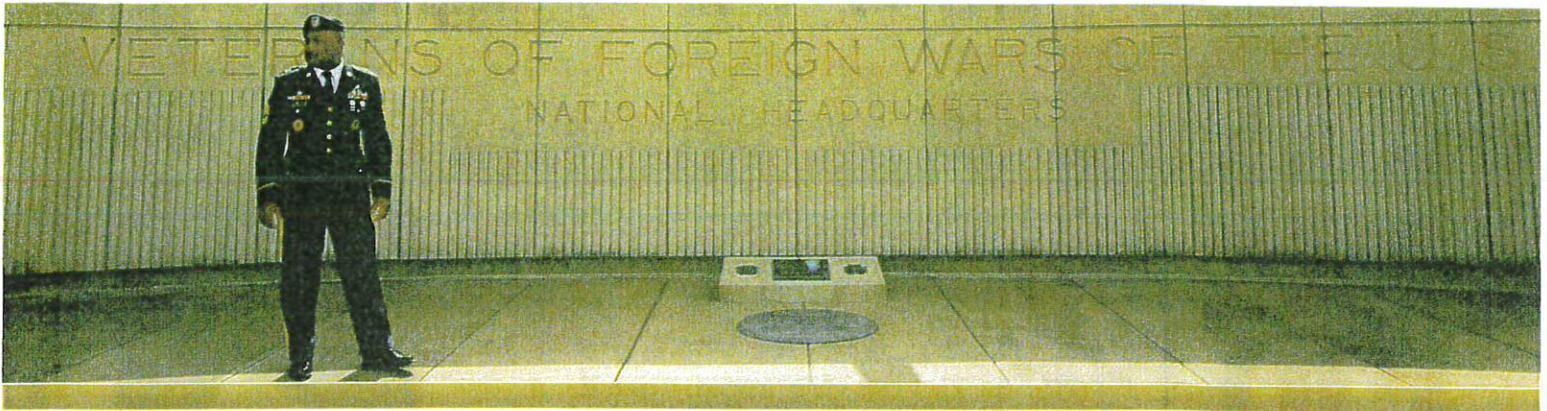

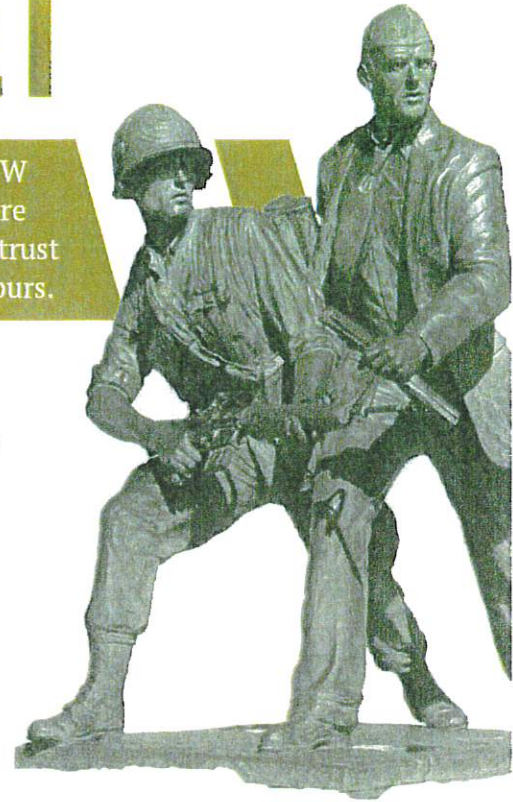

Who, what, when, where & why

Be sure to include complete information in a press release or communication about an upcoming #StillServing event.



Tap a celebrity

Ask local news and radio personalities to join in sharing and celebrating our veterans' #StillServing efforts. Check if their organization can contribute airtime.

DOCUMENT INITIATIVES WITH PHOTOGRAPHS!

- **Select a Photographer**—Ask one person to handle photography. Give them a clear list on what you want.
- **Get in Close**—Focus in on faces and capture the emotion and excitement of the event.
- **Capture the Action**—A posed photo can work, but a candid shot when the action is happening will really capture what's going on.
- **Get Names**—Identify who is in your photos. This will be needed for captions and any media use.
- **Use Photo Releases**—It's important to have permission to use photographs of anyone. Be certain to get parental permission if there are kids present.

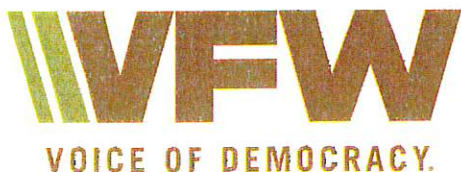
How do I get a flag from the post office?

Burial Flags

1. Submit a completed VA Form 27-2008 and attach a copy of the veteran's DD-214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty to your local **Post Office™**
2. Applications can be submitted by family members or a funeral director acting on their behalf.
3. There is no time limit for requesting a **flag**.

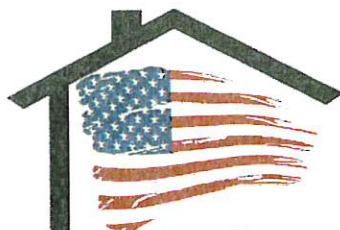

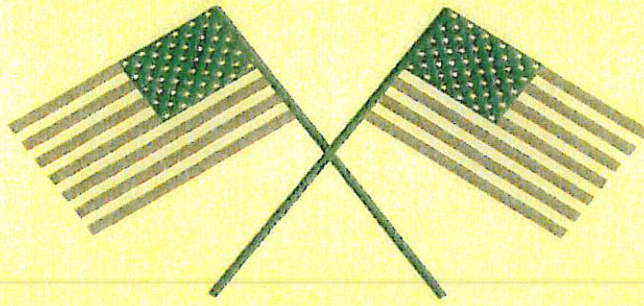
